General Information

Governance: Being economically-oriented, the governance of "green" projects is especially weak. However, the company recognises the need and trends towards this direction seriously.

Requirements

Management would like the students representing Global to take a broad study or survey and making recommendations to the management team to improve all 3 aspects of the ESG, including technologies and investment needs.

Students are requested to investigate and outline the procedures and processes leading to such sustainable outcomes, and we will take a serious approach to implementing the practical solutions.
